



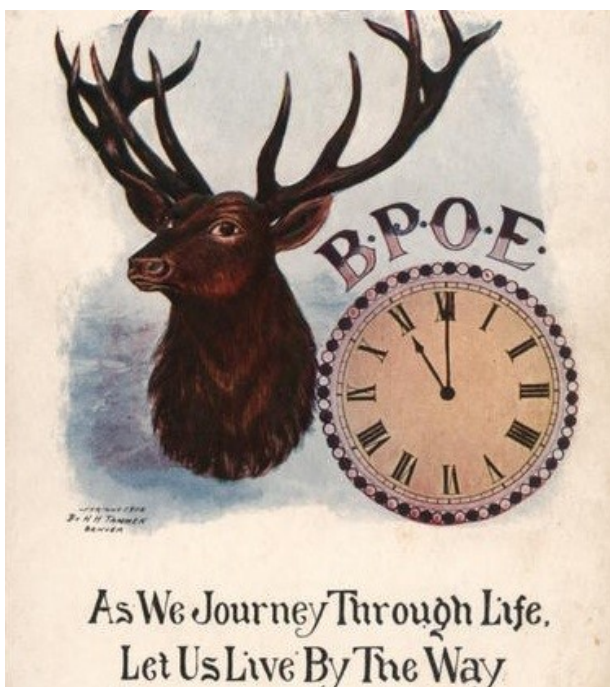
Trav'l'n Elks
